Trust the impressions and emotions that arise, as they form the basis of your intuitive interpretation.

Spirit, your Guides, and loved ones communicate with you through the language of the cards, uniquely tailored to your way of understanding. As you become more attuned to this visual and emotional vocabulary, the cards transform into a powerful tool for receiving guidance. Each card you draw is a piece







## Intuitively Reading Tarot

The Tarot is a profound and versatile tool for divination, self-reflection, and spiritual exploration. It's often perceived to require predestined spiritual "gifts" to hear Spirit and be guided in sharing the message of the cards. But, I'm here to tell you, one (1), you can be as intuitive or connected to Spirit as the next person, and two (2) you can read Tarot intuitively. So, use your intuition, "listen" to the guidance you "feel" within you.

But, you're reading this to understand the prescribed meanings of the Tarot. So, below we provide insights into some traditional interpretations of the cards. As you read, you may wish to turn to these definitions in supporting your intuitive insights, aligning them with your messages for yourself or your sitter.

### Abbreviated, Card Meanings of the Tarot

Through its rich symbolism and archetypal imagery, the traditional Tarot taps into universal themes and experiences, guiding individuals through personal growth and transformation. Each reading provides a narrative that helps illuminate hidden aspects of the self, uncovering truths and facilitating a deeper understanding of life's challenges and opportunities. The Tarot's intricate interplay of cards fosters intuitive insights and sparks meaningful connections, offering a holistic and nuanced perspective on the complexities of human experience. Its blend of mysticism, psychology, and art makes the tarot a unique and powerful medium for gaining clarity, wisdom, and empowerment.

## The Major Arcana

The Major Arcana represents significant life events, spiritual lessons, and deep insights. Each card embodies energies and themes, guiding individuals through transformative experiences and key stages of personal development. They offer wisdom, highlighting pivotal moments and the journey of self-discovery.

0. The Fool: Embarking on a journey with boundless optimism, innocence, and spontaneity, embracing the unknown and new beginnings fearlessly. Signals your readiness to start fresh and trust the process.
1. The Magician: Harnessing power, skill, and resourcefulness to manifest goals through focused intent and inspired action. Signals your potential to create and achieve.
2. The High Priest/Priestess: Embracing intuition, mystery, and subconscious knowledge; secrets and wisdom lie beneath the surface. Encourages you to trust your inner voice.
3. The Empress: Nurturing, creativity, and abundance; embodying maternal care and the flourishing of life. Suggests you are in a period of growth and creativity.
4. The Emperor: Authority, structure, and control; embodying leadership, stability, and strategic planning. Indicates you need to assert control and make decisive actions.

5. The Hierophant: Tradition, spiritual wisdom, and guidance; seeking knowledge from established institutions and mentors. Advises you to seek guidance from trusted sources.

6. The Lovers: Union, harmony, and choices; representing meaningful relationships and important life decisions. Highlights your need to make balanced and heartfelt choices.

7. The Chariot: Determination, willpower, and victory; triumphing over obstacles through disciplined effort and focus. Signifies your ability to achieve success through perseverance.

8. Strength: Inner courage, compassion, and resilience; overcoming challenges with grace and patience. Encourages you to tap into your inner strength and kindness.

9. The Hermit: Solitude, introspection, and inner guidance; seeking wisdom through reflection and meditation. Suggests you take time for self-discovery and contemplation.

10. Wheel of Fortune: Change, cycles, and fate; embracing life's constant flux and the turning points of destiny. Indicates you are entering a new phase with unpredictable outcomes.

11. Justice: Fairness, truth, and balance; embodying ethical decisions and the law of cause and effect. Advises you to consider the consequences of your actions and seek fairness.

12. The Hanged Man: Surrender, perspective, and letting go; finding enlightenment through a shift in viewpoint. Encourages you to embrace new perspectives and release old patterns.

13. Death: Transformation, endings, and new beginnings; embracing change and the cycle of life. Signals you are undergoing significant change and personal transformation.

14. Temperance: Balance, harmony, and moderation; blending elements to create a cohesive whole. Suggests you find balance in your life through moderation and patience.

15. The Devil: Temptation, materialism, and bondage; confronting fears and breaking free from destructive patterns. Warns you of the need to confront and overcome your limitations.

16. The Tower: Sudden upheaval, revelation, and chaos; embracing the collapse of false structures for true growth. Indicates you will face sudden change, leading to a better foundation.

17. The Star: Hope, inspiration, and renewal; finding peace and guidance from within and the universe. Encourages you to remain hopeful and seek inner clarity.

18. The Moon: Illusion, intuition, and dreams; navigating the subconscious and embracing the unknown. Suggests you trust your intuition and be wary of illusions.


19. The Sun: Joy, success, and vitality; radiating positivity and achieving fulfillment. Indicates you will experience happiness and success in your endeavors.

20. Judgement: Awakening, reflection, and rebirth; assessing the past to forge a new path forward. Encourages you to embrace self-reflection for personal growth and renewal.

21. The World: Completion, achievement, and unity; celebrating the culmination of a journey and the harmony of all elements. Suggests you have reached a significant milestone and fulfillment.

## The Minor Arcana

The Minor Arcana represents everyday events, practical matters, and personal experiences. Divided into four suits—Swords, Cups, Pentacles, and Wands—each suit explores different aspects of life: intellect, emotions, material concerns, and creativity. These cards provide insight into daily challenges and interactions, offering guidance on how to navigate practical issues, relationships, and personal growth. They highlight the nuances of our actions and decisions, reflecting the smaller, yet significant, moments that shape our journey.

### Swords (Intellect, conflict, decisions)

1. Ace of Swords: New beginnings, clarity, and breakthroughs; mental clarity and intellectual power lead you to new ideas and opportunities.

2. Two of Swords: Indecision, stalemate, and difficult choices; you are at a crossroads and must weigh options carefully to find balance.
3. Three of Swords: Heartbreak, sorrow, and betrayal; emotional pain and grief are present, but healing and understanding will follow.
4. Four of Swords: Rest, recuperation, and contemplation; a time for rest and recovery to gain insight and clarity on your next steps.
5. Five of Swords: Conflict, defeat, and tension; a challenging situation may leave you feeling isolated or victorious at a cost.
6. Six of Swords: Transition, journey, and moving on; you are leaving behind difficulties and moving towards a calmer, more peaceful state.
7. Seven of Swords: Deception, strategy, and cunning; you may need to use tact and discretion to navigate a tricky situation.
8. Eight of Swords: Restriction, limitation, and fear; you feel trapped by your circumstances, but self-awareness can help you break free.
9. Nine of Swords: Anxiety, nightmares, and despair; overwhelming worries and fears are clouding your mind, but confronting them can bring relief.
10. Ten of Swords: Endings, betrayal, and loss; a painful conclusion is near, but it also marks the beginning of a new chapter.
11. Page of Swords: Curiosity, vigilance, and mental agility; you are eager to learn and ready to face challenges with a sharp mind.
12. Knight of Swords: Ambition, action, and determination; you are driven and ready to take swift action to achieve your goals.
13. Queen of Swords: Perceptive, independent, and honest; your clear thinking and unbiased judgment guide you in making fair decisions.
14. King of Swords: Authority, intellect, and truth; you possess strong leadership and analytical skills, making you a decisive and fair leader.





## CUPS (Emotions, Relationships, Love)

1. Ace of Cups: New emotions, beginnings, and intuition; overflowing with love, joy, and spiritual insight, bringing emotional fulfillment.

2. Two of Cups: Partnership, unity, and attraction; a harmonious and balanced relationship or deep connection is forming in your life.

3. Three of Cups: Celebration, friendship, and community; joy and camaraderie abound, highlighting the importance of social connections and shared happiness.

4. Four of Cups: Contemplation, apathy, and reevaluation; you may feel discontent or disconnected, urging you to reassess your emotional needs and desires.

5. Five of Cups: Loss, grief, and disappointment; emotional setbacks are present, but focusing on what remains can lead to healing and renewal.

6. Six of Cups: Nostalgia, memories, and childhood; reflecting on the past brings comfort and lessons that can enrich your present and future.

7. Seven of Cups: Illusions, choices, and imagination; numerous options and fantasies can lead to confusion, urging you to discern reality from illusion.

8. Eight of Cups: Abandonment, journey, and letting go; leaving behind what no longer serves you to seek deeper meaning and personal growth.

9. Nine of Cups: Contentment, satisfaction, and wish fulfillment; your desires are coming to fruition, bringing emotional and material happiness.

10. Ten of Cups: Harmony, fulfillment, and divine love; a sense of complete emotional fulfillment and strong, harmonious relationships in your life.

11. Page of Cups: Creativity, intuition, and new beginnings; you are open to new emotional experiences and creative inspirations.

12. Knight of Cups: Romance, charm, and idealism; a journey driven by emotional desires, seeking beauty, love, and artistic expression.

13. Queen of Cups: Compassion, intuition, and emotional security; deeply empathetic and nurturing, you are in tune with your emotions and those of others.

14. King of Cups: Emotional balance, control, and generosity; a master of your emotions, you offer wise and compassionate guidance to others.





## PENTACLES (Wealth, Material, Career)

1. Ace of Pentacles: New opportunities, prosperity, and manifestation; a seed of potential for material success and abundance is being planted.
2. Two of Pentacles: Balance, adaptability, and time management; juggling multiple responsibilities, you must stay flexible and maintain equilibrium.
3. Three of Pentacles: Collaboration, craftsmanship, and teamwork; working with others to achieve a common goal through skill and cooperation.
4. Four of Pentacles: Security, control, and conservation; holding onto resources tightly, you must balance stability with openness to new opportunities.
5. Five of Pentacles: Hardship, loss, and isolation; financial or material struggles are present, but support and recovery are within reach.
6. Six of Pentacles: Generosity, sharing, and charity; the flow of giving and receiving resources, emphasizing balance and fairness in exchanges.
7. Seven of Pentacles: Patience, assessment, and long-term growth; evaluating progress and investing time and effort for future rewards and success.

8. Eight of Pentacles: Diligence, skill development, and mastery; dedication to honing your craft and working hard to achieve excellence.
9. Nine of Pentacles: Luxury, self-sufficiency, and accomplishment; enjoying the fruits of your labor and appreciating the comforts and achievements of independence.
10. Ten of Pentacles: Legacy, inheritance, and stability; long-term success and fulfillment through family, tradition, and financial security.
11. Page of Pentacles: Ambition, diligence, and new ventures; a message of new beginnings in the material world, encouraging practical steps and learning.
12. Knight of Pentacles: Hard work, responsibility, and reliability; steady and methodical progress towards your goals through perseverance and commitment.
13. Queen of Pentacles: Nurturing, practicality, and resourcefulness; grounded and caring, you create a stable and comfortable environment for yourself and others.
14. King of Pentacles: Wealth, leadership, and stability; successful and confident, you manage your resources wisely and provide for those around you.

## WANDS (Creativity, Action, Ambition)

1. Ace of Wands: Inspiration, new beginnings, and potential; a burst of creative energy and enthusiasm, igniting your passions and ideas.

2. Two of Wands: Planning, foresight, and exploration; evaluating your options and making plans for future ventures and opportunities.

3. Three of Wands: Expansion, progress, and anticipation; your efforts are beginning to bear fruit, and you're looking ahead to new horizons.

4. Four of Wands: Celebration, stability, and harmony; a period of joy and contentment, often marked by communal success and happy gatherings.

5. Five of Wands: Conflict, competition, and struggle; navigating challenges and disputes that test your resolve and determination.

6. Six of Wands: Victory, recognition, and achievement; your hard work and perseverance are acknowledged, bringing public acclaim and personal satisfaction.

7. Seven of Wands: Defense, perseverance, and resilience; standing your ground and defending your position against challenges and opposition.

8. Eight of Wands: Speed, action, and movement; rapid progress and swift developments are occurring, driving you towards your goals with momentum.

9. Nine of Wands: Resilience, courage, and persistence; overcoming obstacles and pushing forward despite fatigue and setbacks, showing strength and determination.

10. Ten of Wands: Burden, responsibility, and hard work; carrying heavy responsibilities and feeling the weight of your commitments, reminding you to seek balance.

11. Page of Wands: Enthusiasm, exploration, and discovery; a youthful and adventurous spirit, eager to embark on new creative and personal endeavors.


12. Knight of Wands: Passion, adventure, and impulsiveness; a bold and dynamic energy driving you to pursue your ambitions with vigor and confidence.

14. King of Wands: Leadership, vision, and influence; a powerful and visionary leader, guiding others with your bold ideas and unwavering determination.







# Introduction to the Chakras

Chakras are energy centers within the human body that are believed to influence our physical, emotional, and spiritual well-being. There are seven main chakras, each located at a specific point along the spine and associated with a specific color. (1) The Root Chakra (Muladhara) is red and is the foundation of our energy system, representing grounding, stability, and our connection to the Earth. (2) The Sacral Chakra (Svadhithana) is orange and symbolizes creativity and passion. (3) The Solar Plexus Chakra (Manipura) is yellow and embodies personal power and confidence. (4) The Heart Chakra (Anahata) is green and signifies love and compassion. (5) The Throat Chakra (Vishuddha) is blue and relates to communication. (6) The Third Eye Chakra (Ajna) is indigo and involves intuition and insight. (7) The Crown Chakra (Sahasrara) is violet and connects to spirituality and enlightenment. Even understanding these basics on the chakras can enhance readings, allowing for deeper insights into our card readings, energy, and life path.

**The Root Chakra**, or Muladhara, is the first of the seven primary chakras and is located at the base of the spine. Represented by the color red, it is the foundation of our physical and energetic stability. This chakra is essential for grounding, providing a sense of security, and fulfilling basic needs like food, shelter, and safety. It's my belief that our life's experiences can impact the condition of our Root Chakra. Acknowledging those experiences (grounding) can help in having a balanced Root Chakra, promoting feelings of safety, confidence, and resilience. Imbalances can result in fear, anxiety, and instability.




The seven major Chakras rise up from the pelvis through our chest and up through the crown of our head.


**The Sacral Chakra**, or Svadhithana, is the second chakra located just below the navel. It is associated with the color orange and governs our creativity, passion, and emotional expression. This energy center influences our sense of pleasure, sexuality, and the flow of our emotions. A balanced Sacral Chakra enhances creativity, joy, and healthy relationships, allowing us to connect deeply with others and embrace our desires. Conversely, imbalances may result in emotional turbulence, creative blocks, and intimacy issues. Understanding and harmonizing




The feeling of the Chakras

the Sacral Chakra is essential for fostering creativity, emotional balance, and a fulfilling connection to life's pleasures.

**The Solar Plexus Chakra**, or Manipura, is the third chakra situated in the upper abdomen. It is symbolized by the color yellow and is the core of personal power, self-confidence, and autonomy. This chakra influences our sense of self-worth, determination, and ability to manifest our goals. I refer to the Solar Plexus as the "Can Do" Chakra. A balanced Solar Plexus Chakra brings about self-assurance, motivation, and a clear sense of purpose, empowering us to act decisively and assert our individuality. When imbalanced, it can cause issues like low self-esteem, indecision, or domineering behavior. Balancing the Solar Plexus Chakra is essential for nurturing personal power, confidence, and inner strength.

**The Heart Chakra**, or Anahata, is the fourth chakra, situated in the center of the chest. Symbolized by the color green, it is the seat of love, compassion, and emotional harmony. This chakra influences our ability to love unconditionally, empathize with others, and forgive. When balanced, the Heart Chakra fosters strong relationships, self-love, and emotional stability, enabling us to connect deeply and authentically with others. Imbalances can manifest as loneliness, bitterness, or relational difficulties. Balancing the Heart Chakra is essential for developing compassion, nurturing healthy relationships, and achieving emotional equilibrium.


**The Throat Chakra**, or Vishuddha, is the fifth chakra located at the throat and is represented by the color blue. It is the hub of communication, self-expression, and truthfulness. This chakra influences our ability to convey thoughts and emotions clearly, listen deeply, and express our authentic selves. When the Throat Chakra is balanced, it promotes effective communication, creative expression, and the confident sharing of ideas. An imbalance can cause difficulties in speaking up, fear of judgment, or dishonesty. Balancing the Throat Chakra is essential for clear communication, genuine self-expression, and fostering meaningful connections with others.

**The Third Eye Chakra**, or Ajna, is the sixth chakra located between the eyebrows and is symbolized by the color indigo. It is the center of intuition, inner vision, and higher consciousness. This chakra influences our ability to see beyond the physical realm, access deep insights, and develop psychic abilities. A balanced Third Eye Chakra fosters heightened intuition, clear perception, and spiritual awareness, enabling us to trust our inner wisdom and see the larger perspective. Imbalances can cause confusion, lack of direction, or disconnection from intuition. Balancing the Third Eye Chakra is crucial for enhancing insight, mental clarity, and spiritual enlightenment. I consider the Third Eye to be to be very related to the Crown Chakra in its facilitating our "clairs", like clairvoyance, clairsentience, clairgustance, etc.

**The Crown Chakra**, or Sahasrara, is the seventh chakra, located at the top of the head and symbolized by the color violet or white. It is the gateway to spiritual connection, enlightenment, and universal

awareness. This chakra influences our link to the divine, inner wisdom, and transcendence. A balanced Crown Chakra fosters spiritual awakening, profound understanding, and a deep sense of unity with the universe. Imbalances can manifest as feelings of isolation, purposelessness, or spiritual disconnection. Balancing the Crown Chakra is vital for achieving spiritual enlightenment, inner serenity, and a strong connection to the greater cosmos.

## My Thoughts on the Chakras

The seven major chakras work together to create a harmonious flow of energy throughout the body, influencing our physical, emotional, and spiritual well-being. Starting at the base of the spine, the Root Chakra provides grounding and stability. The Sacral Chakra, located below the navel, fuels creativity and passion. The Solar Plexus Chakra, in the upper abdomen, empowers confidence and personal power. The Heart Chakra, at the center of the chest, nurtures love and compassion. The Throat Chakra, in the throat, enables clear communication. The Third Eye Chakra, between the eyebrows, enhances intuition and insight. Finally, the Crown Chakra, at the top of the head, connects us to spiritual enlightenment and universal consciousness. Together, they balance and energize our entire being.

Some believe that aligning all seven chakras is essential for optimal well-being, as it ensures a harmonious flow of energy throughout the body. Balanced chakras enhance physical health, emotional stability, and spiritual growth, promoting overall harmony and allowing us to function at our highest potential in all aspects of life. When some chakras are not aligned, it disrupts the flow of energy, leading to physical, emotional, or spiritual imbalances. As an example, these are often experienced in our mood, physical limitations, or mindset. These misalignments can manifest as health issues, emotional instability, or a lack of clarity and purpose. Achieving balance among all chakras can be vital for holistic well-being and harmony.

That said, even if some chakras are not aligned, people can still lead happy and fulfilling lives. While imbalances might cause occasional challenges, you may continue to find great joys in your relationships, hobbies, and personal growth. Your striving for balance improves well-being, but it isn't necessary for happiness. Remember, no one is "broken" if their chakras aren't perfectly aligned. Understanding chakras can certainly highlight areas to focus on,

such as how we relate to others, our diet, in how we problem-solve, or hold self-respect. I like to think that our life lessons and experiences hold an integral part of guiding us toward greater alignment, helping us grow and achieve deeper balance and harmony.

As I share this, I want to emphasize that I, too, am still learning about the Chakras. I share this basic overview and information to help you understand how they can enhance your oracle and tarot card readings, whether for yourself or others.

## Spiritual Connections in Color

The meaning of any one color, or combination is very personal and can be very much shaped through your life experiences. Don't deviate from these personal definitions; Spirit communicates with you through the language of your life-experiences.

In absence of your own interpretations or in further support, I provide the following color guidance for your consideration and use. While these may be considered more universally accepted definitions of spiritual color meanings, your own intuition and feelings around colors should be your primary source in interpreting color in your readings [These are alphabetical].

**Black** represents the depth of the unconscious and the mysteries of existence. It is a color that aids in deep meditation and introspection, helping to uncover hidden truths. Spiritually, black signifies the presence of barriers or the need for inner exploration.

**Blue** is the color of spiritual awakening, intuition, and divine inspiration. It promotes inner peace and tranquility, providing a calming influence on the soul. In the spiritual realm, blue indicates a state of serenity and a deep connection to higher wisdom.



## About Intuitive Intention

Purposefully, Rob named his small business “Intuitive Intention”. Early in his spiritual journey, these words best described his “go with the flow” attitude, now also aligning with his path with Spirit. He quickly found oracle cards as an easy method of sharing Spirit’s messages for himself and others. Reading cards for others continues to be one of his greatest joys.

In this early journey, Rob had avoided reading Tarot cards, being aware of the perceived intensity around the meaning and story within each suit, the two arcanum, each card, and in the countless card “pulls” formats. But, in 2021, Rob was inspired to design his own Tarot cards as a method of teaching himself this complex spiritual language. What Rob realized in that effort was that the Tarot is a vocabulary and language in which to translate energy/messages from Spirit. And, in the same way he read Oracle, he could read Tarot intuitively, too.

As such, Rob’s Tarot and Oracle decks are designed for intuitive exploration and insight, for beginners and seasoned-readers, alike. The **Intuitive Intention Tarot Deck** was developed on a creative journey of intuitively creating imagery that aligned with the message of each Tarot position / card. Intent-fully, the cards were designed with common imagery, colors, and subject matter that assists in the interpretation of the messages from Spirit. Readers can feel into their own intuition and/or use the Tarot labeling.



*The Intuitive City Oracle Deck*

About 9 months later, Rob was ready to dive into his previously favored format of Oracle cards. Inspired by 1920-1930 futuristic, black and white movies, **The Intuitive City Oracle** deck was developed to draw inspiration from the resilience and community spirit of 1930s American life during the Great Depression. Similar to his design of the Tarot cards, the Oracle cards utilize imagery, symbols, and colors that evoke each reader's intuitive interpretation of the card meaning and/or message from Spirit. The later nuance that was added to the deck is the additional alignment to the Tarot; each card has an Oracle and Tarot label, in the upright and reverse.

Most recently, in August of 2024, Rob published the **The Intuitive Impressions Tarot Deck**. Influenced by the folded ink blot patterns of the 1930 psychiatric tests and wishing to connect to our interpretation of colors (aligned with our Chakras), this deck makes an additional step deeper into promoting our connection with our intuition. The deck seeks our interpretation of ink blots, shapes, patterns, Chakras, and colors, tapping into our personal, life-learned vocabulary and language, supported by the traditional Tarot Card labeling. It is in this way, Rob developed a third deck to connect with, and receive messages from Spirit.

Together, these three decks provide a unique blend of historical context and spiritual insight, guiding you through intuitive readings and deeper self-awareness, all focused on your acknowledgment and growth of your own intuition and connection to Spirit.
